## Water Sampling Guide





## Container/Bottle:

- Sample a minimum of 1L in a container that has been thoroughly cleaned.
- Preferably use a plastic container for safe shipping.
- Place the container in a box to protect from direct sunlight, if possible.
- A prepared water bottle works well. For example, purchase a 1L bottle of still water and decant contents before sampling.
- Add your name, contact details and sample description to the bottle or package.

## Sampling:

- Run the water source for a period of +/-10 minutes (or until the pipeline is clear) before sampling to ensure the sample is representative of the source.
- Fill the sample bottle without too much disturbance to the water.
- Seal the bottle and prepare for shipping.

## Please Note:

- **DO NOT** sample from the tank. Samples must be from the source.
- DO NOT sample after any filtration, unless you want to test the filtered water.
- DO NOT contaminate or alter the water in any way. We need to test the quality of the source.
